ORDER

WHEREAS Security National Insurance Company, Primmum Insurance Company and TD Home and Auto Insurance Company, collectively the TD Insurance Group (“TD” or “Group”) made an application to the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board (“Board”) on April 27, 2017, for approval to adopt the 2017 CLEAR (Collison, DCPD and Comprehensive Separated) Rate Group Table, effective November 1, 2017, for both new business and renewal business (“Application”);

AND WHEREAS the Application was filed in accordance with the Board’s *Rate Filing Requirements for Automobile Insurance – Section 155G – CLEAR (“Requirements”)*;

AND WHEREAS after review and consideration of the Application, the Board determined that the Application complies with the *Insurance Act and Regulations*;

AND WHEREAS the Board finds that TD provided updated profiles that show a reasonable range of impacts for the selected vehicles using the correct rating groups and that the implementation of the new Table will result in a small overall premium impact and an acceptable premium dislocation distribution;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Application by TD to adopt the 2017 CLEAR (Collison, DCPD and Comprehensive Separated) Rate Group Table, is hereby approved for the effective date of November 1, 2017, for both new business for renewal business.
