DECISION AND ORDER

WHEREAS Markie Bus Tours (Applicant) filed Amendment Applications on July 15, 2019, with the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board, requesting to amend Motor Carrier License No. P01922 and Extra-Provincial Operating License XP02441 (Licenses), by adding two (2) 50-passenger activity buses to Schedules E(1) and E(2) of the Licenses to operate under the existing rates and authorities.

AND WHEREAS a Notice of Amendment Application was published in the Royal Gazette on July 24, 2019, posted on the Board's website and forwarded to licensed carriers by email, fax or letter;

AND WHEREAS no written objections were received by the stated deadline;

AND WHEREAS the Board considered the Applications and filed information by way of a paper hearing on August 14, 2019;

AND WHEREAS having considered the *Motor Carrier Act*, including the factors set out in s. 13, the Board finds it is in the public interest to approve the Applications;

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Applications are granted, subject to the terms and conditions set out in this Order;
2. The Licenses are amended by adding two (2) 50-passenger activity buses to Schedules E(1) and E(2); and
3. If the Applicant does not action the amendments granted in this Order within 60 days or such further period permitted by the Board upon request of the Applicant, the Applicant is no longer authorized to operate the motor vehicles in accordance with the amendments.
