NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

THE TOWN OF ANTIGONISH, on behalf of its Electric Utility, has made an application to the Board for Approval of Amendments to its Schedule of Rates and Charges for the provision of electric supply and services to its customers and its Schedule of Rules and Regulations.

This matter will be considered in a public hearing as follows:

Depending on the circumstances related to Covid-19, this public hearing may be held by video conference.

Board Hearings are open to the public and you may participate in one of the following ways:

- You may speak at the hearing. You must notify the Board by **Tuesday, March 19, 2024.**
- You may make written comments by sending a letter to the Clerk of the Board at P.O. Box 1692, Unit "M", Halifax, NS B3J 3S3, or by email at: board@novascotia.ca, or by fax at (902) 424-3919 by **Tuesday, March 19, 2024.**
- You may request formal standing as an Intervenor, subject to Board approval. This will allow you to present evidence or cross-examine witnesses. Your request must be received by the Board by **Monday, January 15, 2024**, and a copy of your written evidence by **Tuesday, February 20, 2024.**

Additional information about the matter is as follows:

The Town of Antigonish has applied for an increase of 6.3% in its revenue requirement, effective April 1, 2024. The increases in revenue requirements by rate class are as follows:

Rate Class	Increase
Domestic	7.2%
Domestic Time of Day	7.5%
General up to 3 KW load	7.2%
General > 3 KW load	7.2%
Large General	0.0%
Street Light	7.9%

The Utility is also proposing changes to its Schedule of Rules and Regulations.

Upon reviewing the Application, the Board, in its Decision, may determine that the proposed amendments should be as requested, higher, or lower.
