## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**IN THE MATTER OF AN APPLICATION** filed by **THE TOWN OF MAHONE BAY ELECTRIC UTILITY** to amend its Schedules of Rates and Charges by amending the municipal pass-through formulas to flow through approved changes in Nova Scotia Power Inc.'s (NS Power's) approved rates and to implement the new formula for approved changes to NS Power's rates for its municipal rate class on January 1, 2024.
