THE DIGBY WATER COMMISSION has applied for approval of amendments to its Schedule of Rates and Charges for Water and Water Services and amendments to its Schedule of Rules and Regulations

- You may request formal standing as an Intervener, subject to Board approval. This will allow you to present evidence or cross-examine witnesses. Your request must be received by the Board by Monday, February 26, 2024 and a copy of your written evidence by Wednesday, April 3, 2024.

Additional information about the matter is as follows:

• For a 5/8" meter, residential customer, the bi-monthly water bill is proposed to increase from \$52.58 to \$56.40 (a 7.3% increase) in 2024/25; \$60.71 (7.7% increase) in 2025/26; and \$65.06 (7.2% increase) in 2026/27.

- The Utility is requesting increases to rates for other metered customers, those with bi-monthly bills are proposed to change between -10.8% and 37.8% in 2024/25; 1.2% to 17.4% in 2025/26; and 4.8% to 10.3% in 2026/27.
- The annual public fire protection charge paid by the Town of Digby is currently \$239,057 and will increase to \$255,389 (6.8%) for 2024/25, to \$282,311 (10.5%) in 2025/26 and to \$318,431 (12.8%) in 2026/27. The Utility proposes to prorate the fire protection charges in 2024/25 using 2 months at the previous year's rate and 10 months at the current year's rate.

Upon reviewing the Application, the Board, in its Decision, may determine that the proposed amendments should be as requested, higher, or lower.
