## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

- You may request formal standing as an Intervenor, subject to Board approval. This will allow you to present evidence or cross-examine witnesses. Your request must be received by the Board by Tuesday, November 19, 2024, and a copy of your written evidence by Wednesday, December 4, 2024, for Intervenors supporting the Appellants, and by Monday, December 30, 2024, for Intervenors supporting the Municipality.
- Alternatively, you may request a copy of the audio file for the proceeding after the hearing by contacting the Clerk of the Board.
