Riverport Electric Light Commission (RELC) applied to the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board on November 6, 2024, for approval to begin recovering deferred revenue from the phasing in of a rate increase the Board approved in RELC's last general rate application (M10810). RELC seeks Board approval to recover its deferred revenue from its Domestic and Small General Service rate class customers over a 25-month period, beginning December 1, 2024.
