HEARING ORDER

On December 5, 2024, Port Hawkesbury Paper LP (PHP) requested that the Board confirm PHP will not be responsible for the repayment of any costs related to NS Power's \$500 million regulatory asset associated with Muskrat Falls related energy as part of the tolls, rates and charges PHP pays to NS Power, stating that it fully paid its fuel and purchased power costs.

The Board has determined that this proceeding will be conducted by way of a paper hearing.

The Board orders as follows:
