## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**TYRA INNIS-HARVIE and CHRISTOPHER HARVIE** have made an appeal to the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board from a decision of the Municipality of the County of Kings Council to approve an application for a Land Use By-Law Map Amendment by Nick Bentley to allow rezoning from residential one and two unit (R2) zone to residential multi-unit (R4) zone to permit multi-unit dwellings on properties located on Brooklyn Street, North Kentville, Nova Scotia (PIDs 55047856, 55472955 and 55473987)

- You may request formal standing as an Intervenor, subject to Board approval. This will allow you to present evidence or cross-examine witnesses. Your request must be received by the Board by Wednesday, March 26, 2025, and a copy of your written evidence by Thursday, April 3, 2025, for Intervenors supporting the Appellants, and by Thursday, April 24, 2025, for Intervenors supporting the Municipality.

• Alternatively, you may request a copy of the audio file for the proceeding after the hearing by contacting the Clerk of the Board.
