DECISION AND ORDER

Kings Transit Authority applied to the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board on January 17, 2025, to amend its Motor Carrier License No. P02825 by temporarily suspending its fixed route fares for Route 5E, the Weymouth to Cornwallis route, and Route 5W, the Cornwallis to Weymouth route on the dates noted below. All other route fares will be collected as normal.

Route 5E and 5W – July 4 to 6, 2025 – Lobster Bash Weekend
Route 5E and 5W – August 7 to 10, 2025 – Scallop Days Weekend
Route 5E and 5W – August 28 to 31, 2025 – Wharf Rat Rally Weekend
Route 5E and 5W – December 10 to 24, 2025 – Christmas Holidays

Notice of the application was published in the Royal Gazette on Wednesday, January 29, 2025, and notice provided to the industry. No objections were received by the stated deadline of February 5, 2025.

The application was considered by the Board without a hearing on February 6, 2025.

Having considered the *Motor Carrier Act*, including the factors set out in s. 13, the Board finds it is in the public interest to approve the application.

The Board approves the application and orders that the license be amended to temporarily suspend its fixed route fare for Route 5E and Route 5W, the Weymouth to Cornwallis route, on the dates noted above.
