DECISION AND ORDER

Perry Rand Transportation Group Limited applied to the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board on April 10, 2024, for approval to amend its Motor Carrier License P03289 by increasing its rates and adding one 20-passenger vehicle to facilitate an additional route request made by the Nova Scotia Health Authority as per its contract amendment filed with the Board.

Notice of the application was published in the Royal Gazette on Wednesday, April 24, 2024, and notice provided to the industry. There were no objections received by the stated deadline of May 1, 2024.

The application was considered by the Board in a paper hearing on May 2, 2024.

Having considered the *Motor Carrier Act*, including the factors set out in s. 13, the Board finds it is in the public interest to approve the application.

The Board approves the application and orders that the license be amended to increase the rates and add one 20-passenger vehicle in accordance with the contract amendment filed with the Board, effective June 1, 2024.
