DECISION AND ORDER

Sunshine Atlantic Holdings Ltd. applied to the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board on November 1, 2024, for approval to amend its Motor Carrier License P03017 by adding three Mercedes-Benz Sprinter 14-passenger minibuses to operate under its existing rates and authorities.

Notice of the application was published in the Royal Gazette on Wednesday, November 13, 2024, and notice provided to the industry. There were no objections received by the stated deadline of November 20, 2024.

The application was considered by the Board without a hearing on November 21, 2024. The Board accepts the evidence filed in support of the application.

Having considered the Motor Carrier Act, including the factors set out in s. 13, the Board finds it is in the public interest to approve the application.

The Board approves the application and orders that the license be amended as noted above, effective immediately.
