ORDER

A Permit to Construct NSUARB-NG-BP-PC-01 was issued on September 7, 2016, for construction and installation of a steel natural gas pipeline to deliver natural gas to the Bear Head LNG plant near Point Tupper.

On August 4, 2021, the Nova Scotia Registrar of Joint Stock Companies issued a Certificate of Name Change from Bear Paw Pipeline Corporation Inc. to Bear Paw Energy Inc.

By Board Order [2022 NSUARB 183] dated December 12, 2022, the Permit was extended to December 31, 2024.

Bear Paw Energy Inc. applied to the Board on November 12, 2024, to extend the Permit to Construct for a period of two years with no other changes or modifications to the terms and conditions of the Permit to Construct.

The Board considered the matter by way of a paper hearing.

With respect to Permit to Construct NSUARB-NG-BP-PC-01, the Board orders as follows:

1. All references to Bear Paw Pipeline Corporation Inc. on the Permit to Construct shall be amended to read Bear Paw Energy Inc. as the revised name of the Permit holder.

2. Clause 22 shall be amended to read as follows:

Unless extended or earlier terminated, this Permit to Construct shall expire on December 31, 2026.

3. In all other respects, the terms and conditions in the Permit to Construct shall remain in effect.
