NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOVA SCOTIA POWER INCORPORATED (NS POWER) has made Application to the Board for Approval of its 2020-2022 Fuel Stability Plan, including 2020–2022 Base Cost of Fuel Forecast Reset, 2017-2018 Annual Adjustment/Balance Adjustment amounts under the Fuel Adjustment Mechanism (FAM) and direction on the 2019 Annual Adjustment/Balance Adjustment amounts.

The impact of NS Power's Fuel Stability Plan would be a net total annual average rate increase of 2% in each year, with actual increases varying by individual customer class.
