CHANGE IN MOTOR CARRIER LICENSING ADMINISTRATION DUTIES EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 4, 2019

Effective February 4, 2019, the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board will take over all licensing administration duties from the Motor Carrier Division office located in Miller Lake, Fall River.

Board staff will now be responsible for:

- processing and issuing commercial vehicle licenses, motor carrier licenses, vehicle transfers, certificates of authority, plate transfers, renewals, etc.
- processing and issuing temporary authorities
- receiving confirmations of insurance

The Motor Carrier Division at the Miller Lake location will continue to be responsible for:

- Single trip authorities, trip books, and driver handbooks
- All inspection and safety/enforcement issues
