1 **1.0 INTRODUCTION**

2

3 On November 12, 2021 Nova Scotia Power Incorporated (NS Power, Company) filed the Q3
4 Maritime Link Benefits Report that included benefits from July 1 to August 14, 2021, up to the
5 commencement of the Nova Scotia Block. The Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board (NSUARB,
6 Board) reviewed the report and by letter dated November 16, 2021 directed NS Power as follows:

7

8 The Board agrees that it is useful to understand the benefits reported to the start of
9 the NS Block but directs NS Power to update the benefits report to separately
10 identify the benefits received between August 15, 2021 and October 31, 2021. The
11 Board directs that the updated report be filed by Thursday, November 25, 2021.

13 This supplemental report with respect to the benefits received for the period from August 15, 2021
14 to October 31, 2021 inclusive is provided in accordance with the NSUARB's direction.

15

16 In summary, NS Power confirms that from the commencement of the delivery of the Nova Scotia
17 Block on August 15, 2021 to the end of October 31, 2021, 37,925 MWh flowed over the Maritime
18 Link. NS Power has determined that the Company achieved a total of \$ [REDACTED] in quantified
19 benefits for customers associated with the Maritime Link from August 15, 2021 up to the end of
20 October 31, 2021.

22 Total quantifiable benefits in 2021, up to October 31, 2021, were \$9,628,169 compared to 2020
23 full year benefits of \$4,164,086. The specific details with respect to the quantifiable benefits
24 achieved are provided in Confidential Appendix A.

1 **2.0 AUGUST 15 TO OCTOBER 31, 2021 MARITIME LINK BENEFITS**

3 For the period from August 15, 2021 to October 31, 2021 inclusive, NS Power received from
4 Nalcor a total of 30,957 MWh of energy.

5

6 **2.1 Additional Commentary**

7

8 NS Power received from Nalcor 6,952 MWh of energy from August 15, 2021 to August 31, 2021
9 and 24,005 MWh of energy in September 2021. No energy was received from Nalcor over the
10 Maritime Link in October. However, it is noted that energy flow from Nalcor resumed in
11 November and as of the date of this report has reached more than 24,000 MWh month to date.

12

13 Value was also created through the sale of wheel-through transmission between the New
14 Brunswick border to Bottom Brook, Newfoundland in September and October 2021, totaling
15 \$ [REDACTED] and \$ [REDACTED] respectively.

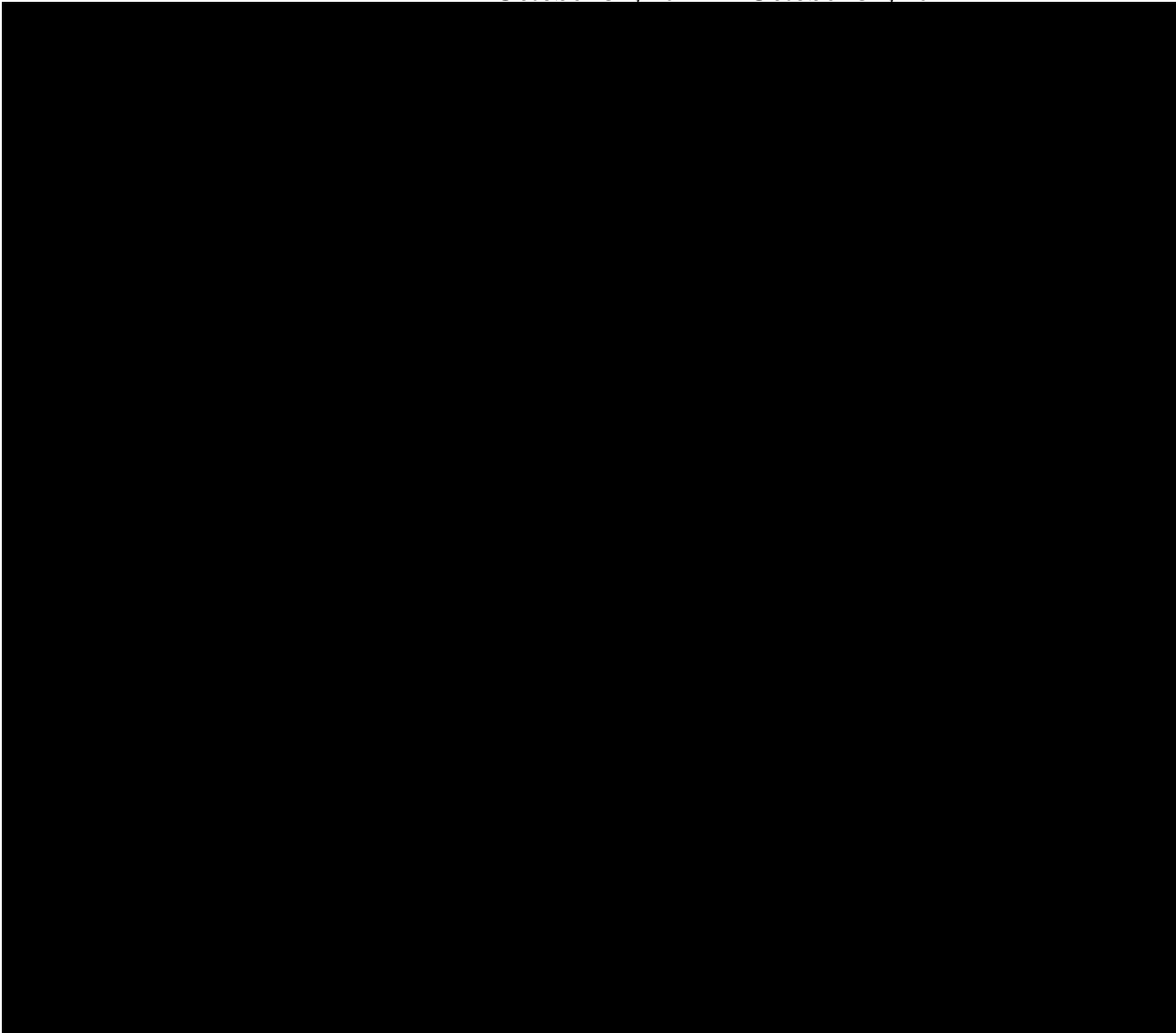
